Board of Trustees Meeting January 18, 2023

The Grundy County Health Department Board of Trustees met in open session on January 18, 2023. NiCole called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm.

The Board reviewed minutes from the December 15 meeting.

The Board reviewed draft construction bid advertisements prepared by Claire Ashbrook. After some discussion, the Board opted not to require bid, performance, or payment bonds.

The Board reviewed draft revisions to the Drug-Free Workplace policy.

Approve the revised Drug-Free Workplace policy as presented. All were in favor, the motion passed.

The Board discussed Quest blood draws offered by the Health Department. A member of the public contacted Jewell to request that additional days/tests be offered. GCHD offers a menu of tests at twice monthly clinics. Elizabeth told the Board that days are added as needed and GCHD offers offsite testing for area employers. Jewell and Elizabeth will gather more information and report at a future meeting.

The Board discussed the COVID-19 vaccination consent process. The Board reviewed GCHD consent forms as well as consent forms developed by Missouri DHSS and St. Louis County Public Health Department that were presented for consideration by Stacey. Elizabeth will consult with other health departments and Missouri DHSS to find the most current consent forms in use.

Elizabeth presented an agency report.
