Board of Trustees Meeting

February 11, 2026

Board members present: Dennis McDonald, Jewell Harris, and J. A. Keuhn (GCHD). Tammie Spencer and Stacey McCullough (via conference call). Others in attendance: Elizabeth Gibson, Shelby Roof-Ewald, Kelli Hillerman, Joy Stotts, Sherry Searcy, LeAnn Tolle, and Glen Briggs.

The Grundy County Health Department Board of Trustees met in open session on February 11, 2026. Stacey called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm.

The Board reviewed minutes from the January meeting.

Motion by Jewell, second by Dr. Keuhn
Approve the minutes of the January 14 meeting. All were in favor, the motion passed.

Elizabeth presented financial reports for January 2026.

Approve the financial report, check listing, and bank balance report for January 2026. All were in favor, the motion passed.

Elizabeth presented an account balance report showing current CD interest rates and maturity dates.

Glen Briggs presented information about the county Hazard Mitigation plan. All counties are required to have a mitigation plan to address natural disasters. Kelli represented the Health Department in county-wide meetings to create the document. GCHD must adopt the plan to be eligible for disaster funding. The Board reviewed a draft resolution to support the plan.

Motion by Dr. Keuhn, second by Jewell
Adopt the Grundy County Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. All were in favor, the motion passed.

Glen presented information about the county emergency notification system or reverse-911. The system is used to notify residents in the event of an emergency. GCHD has been a partner since along with Grundy County and the City of Trenton since the program was initiated. Additional partners, PWSD #1 and the City of Laredo, were added in recent years. GCHD's portion of the cost for 2026 is \$999.

Motion by Dennis, second by Dr. Keuhn
Partner with other county entities on the county notification system and pay \$999 to support the cost. All were in favor, the motion passed.

Elizabeth presented a report of GCHD activities and program numbers for 2025.
